O konferenci

Konferenca bo po obliki podobna kot dosedanjih 20 demografskih v okviru multikonference Informacijska družba (is.ijs.si). Ko smo desetletje in pol predstavljali demografske projekcije in dileme, se je predvsem pred nekaj leti po nastopih v parlamentu dvignilo precej kritik in zanikovanja. V letu 2025 smo izvedli soroden dogodek v slovenskem parlamentu. Sedanji podatki jasno kažejo, da so bile naše projekcije povsem pravilne in tudi za naprej so kredibilne. Posledice zanikovanja znanstvenih ugotovitev se kažejo danes in tu, še bolj pa se bodo v bližnji prihodnosti in naprej. Če ne želimo doživeti demografske in posledično celovite kalvarije, moramo čimprej prenesti spoznanja v javnost in prepričati vodstva držav, da najde primerne rešitve.

Izrazu »evropska demografska zima« se pridružujejo izrazi kot »civilizacijski propad Evrope«, strokovni realistični analizi se ob bok postavljata kot en ekstrem demografska brezbržnost in kot drugi panika, scenariji propada. Tudi Slovenija, Hrvaška in druge države se srečujejo s podobnimi demografskimi izzivi. Projekcije kažejo izumrtje malih evropskih narodov v nekaj stoletjih kot posledico premajhne rodnosti. Skoraj pol stoletja premajhna rodnost preti z dolgoročnimi hudo negativnimi posledicami in kratkoročno zmanjšano kvaliteto življenja v javni in zasebni sferi (družinski odnosi), gospodarstva, pravzaprav večine komponent delovanja družbe in države. Z veliko gotovostjo lahko zapišemo, da bodo demografske odločitve pomembno krojile kakovost življenja ljudi v prihodnjih desetletjih.

Kako se problematike okolja in demografije ustrezno lotiti, kakšni so razvojni trendi in ideje v svetu, EU in v Sloveniji? Vse to bodo teme strokovnih razpravljanj na demografski konferenci Demografske in družinske analize, ki bo potekala v okviru 29. multikonference Informacijska družba.

Vabimo vas, da se udeležite izredno pomembnega dogodka s svojim prispevkom ali s prisostvovanjem na predavanjih. Udeležba na predavanjih je brezplačna.

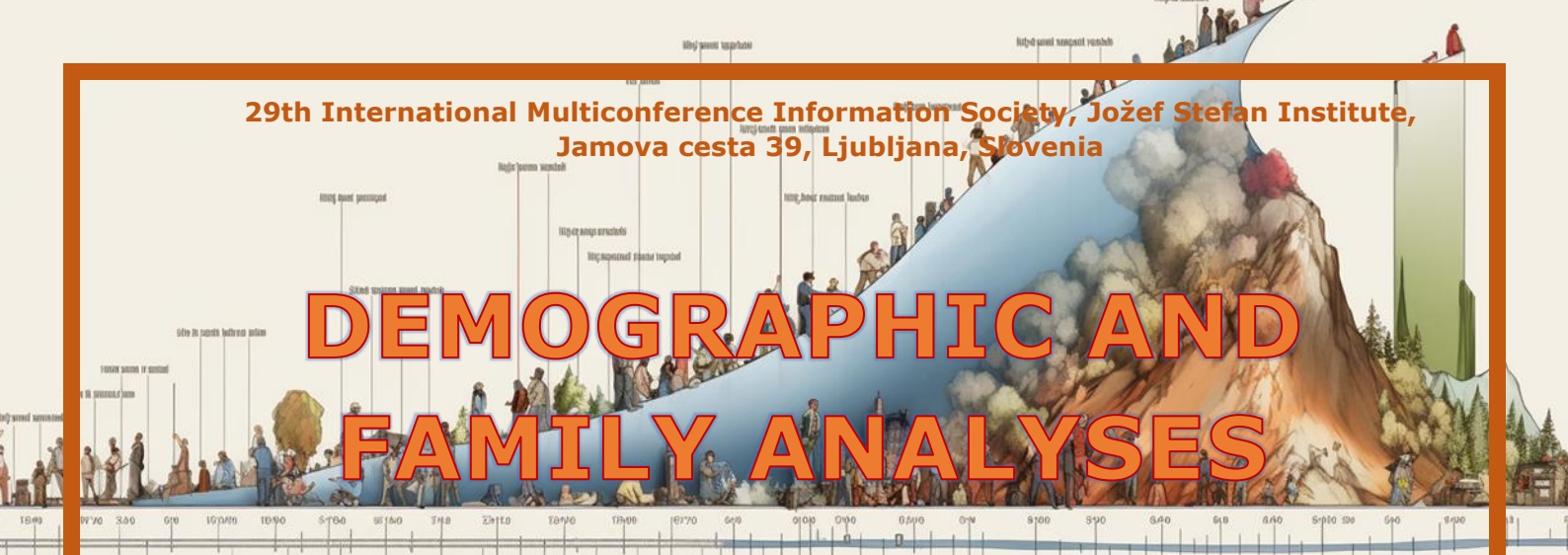

About the conference

The conference will be similar in format to the previous 20 demographic conferences within the Information Society multiconference (<https://is.ijs.si/>). When we presented demographic projections and dilemmas for a decade and a half, a lot of criticism and denial arose, especially a few years ago after our speeches in parliament. In 2025, we organised another parliamentary event. Altogether, current data clearly shows that our projections were completely correct and will continue to be credible. The consequences of denying scientific findings are evident today and here, and will be even more so in the near future and beyond. If we do not want to experience a demographic and consequently comprehensive calvary, we must convey the findings to the public as soon as possible and convince the leaders of the countries to find suitable solutions.

The term "European demographic winter" is joined by terms such as "the civilizational collapse of Europe", professional realistic analysis is juxtaposed with demographic indifference as one extreme and panic, scenarios of collapse as the other. Slovenia, Croatia and other countries are also facing similar demographic challenges. Projections show the extinction of small European nations in a few centuries as a result of low fertility. For almost half a century, low fertility has threatened with long-term, severely negative consequences and a short-term reduced quality of life in the public and private spheres (family relations), the economy, in fact, most components of the functioning of society and the state. We can write with great certainty that demographic decisions will significantly shape the quality of people's lives in the coming decades. How to properly address the problems of the environment and demography, what are the development trends and ideas in the world, the EU and Slovenia? All of these will be the topics of professional discussions at the demographic conference Demographic and Family Analysis, which will be held as part of the 29th multiconference Information Society.

We invite you to participate in this extremely important event by making a contribution or attending the lectures. Participation in the lectures is free of charge.

Instructions to authors

The Program Committee invites authors to participate who can present new ideas and trends in the areas covered by the conference. Both theoretically and empirically based contributions are welcome, but they must always be placed within the framework of professional or scientific work.

The contribution should in principle not exceed four A4 pages, and the shortest length is half an A4 page. It can be written in Slovenian or English. An abstract is mandatory, and the literature and other components must correspond to the usual structure of articles presented at scientific conferences.
