The **SLOVENIAN COGNITIVE SCIENCE CONFERENCE**, organized by the Slovenian Society for Cognitive Science, will be held as part of the **MULTICONFERENCE INFORMATION SOCIETY** at Jožef Stefan Institute in Ljubljana on **7 October 2026**.

The conference brings together researchers and scholars from a wide range of fields, including **neuroscience, psychology, philosophy, artificial intelligence, linguistics, anthropology, and related disciplines**. It aims to foster dialogue across different research areas, methodologies, and theoretical perspectives and is intended to bring together both local and international researchers, from early-career scholars to experienced professionals.

Submissions from all areas of cognitive science are welcome. We particularly encourage contributions (empirical and theoretical) that reflect the diversity of topics, challenges, methods, and insights that define contemporary cognitive science.

Submission, review process, publication

Please submit your **ABSTRACT** (250 words to 1 page, including references) or **SHORT PAPER** (2–4 pages, including references), formatted according to the multiconference template, via the EasyChair platform (template is the same for both types of contributions). Link to the EasyChair submission system and the template are available on the multiconference [webpage](#).

After the submission deadline, you will receive a form where you will **indicate whether you prefer to present your contribution as a talk or a poster**. As the number of talk sessions is limited, the organizing committee may ask some authors to present their work in poster format.

Abstracts and papers will go through a **review process**. In addition, they will receive an automatic language and clarity check supported by a large language model to help authors improve their manuscripts. Submissions in both English and Slovenian are welcome. If submitting in Slovenian, please also include the title, keywords, and an English abstract in the manuscript. Accepted papers will be published in the **conference proceedings**. Preferred language of posters and presentations is English, but Slovene is also possible.

Registration fee

The authors of abstracts and papers must register at the Information Society multiconference [webpage](#) and pay the registration fee. The conference fee is 200 euro for employees, 50 euro for students and 100 euro for other participants (pensioners, unemployed). In the case of contributions with multiple authors, only one registration fee is required per contribution. Registration should be completed either by the first author or by the author who will present the contribution at the conference. For more information, please see the [submission webpage](#). Attending the conference without submission is free of charge.
